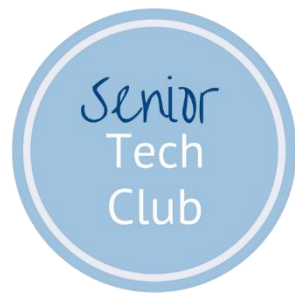

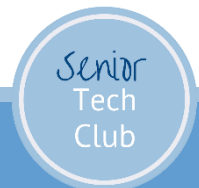

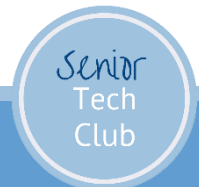

---

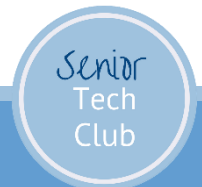


# Typical iPhone Photographer

---

## Actions:

1. Tap Camera icon
2. Tap Shutter



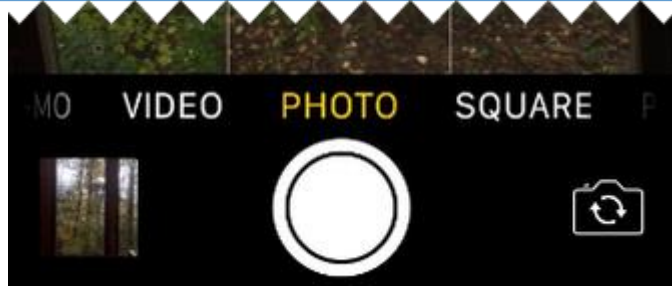
# Launch the Camera App

---

1. Tap on Camera App icon
  - Long Press to reveal shortcuts
2. Camera from the Lock Screen
  - Swipe Left
  - Long Press Camera icon
3. Control Center
  - Long press Camera icon (iPhones w/o Home Button)
4. Siri
  - Take a Photo/Picture
  - Take a Selfie
5. In an App
  - Look for a Camera Icon

# Eight Ways to Release the Shutter

---



2. Volume Buttons
3. Earbud Volume Button (+ or -)
4. Apple Watch
5. Accessory

# Eight Ways to Release the Shutter

---

6. Burst Photos
  - Classic iPhones: Press and Hold Shutter
  - iPhone 11: Swipe (Shift) Shutter to Left



Manage Burst – Display photo, Tap Select

# Eight Ways to Release the Shutter

---

## 7. Timer

- Older iPhone: Tap 
- iPhone 11+ : Tap ^ then 
- Chose 3 or 10 secs
- Tap Shutter to start timer

Timed Photo takes burst of 10 photos

# Eight Ways to Release the Shutter

---

## 8. Quick Take Video (iPhone 11+)

- In Photo mode, Touch & Hold Shutter to take quick video

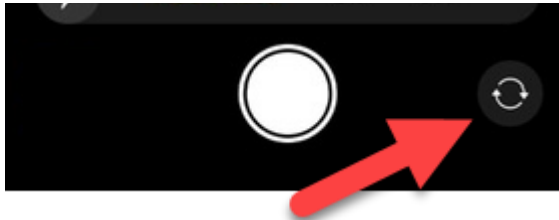
Slide Shutter to right for hands-free recording with both Record and Photo button



# Selfies

---

Switch the Camera



Use the Volume Buttons for the Shutter

# Zoom

---

## Optical vs Digital Zoom

- Better to zoom with your feet than digital

## Digital Zoom – Pinch Screen in or out

## Optical

- If your iPhone has more than one lens, tap:
  - .5x or 1x or 2x (varies by model)

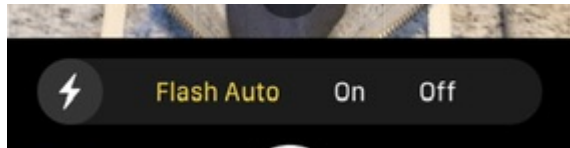
# iPhone 11 Function Layout

---

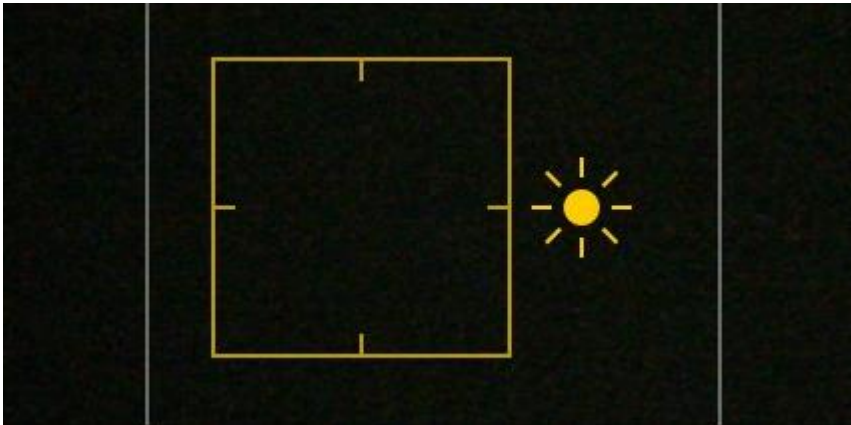


# Focus & Exposure

---

Tap on the Object that you want in focus

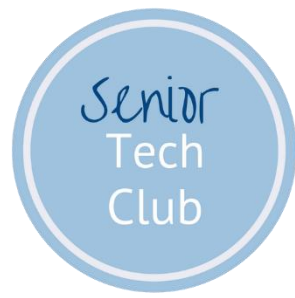
Slide the Sun icon to change the exposure (lighting)

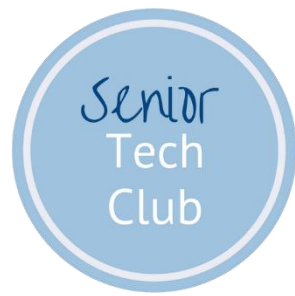

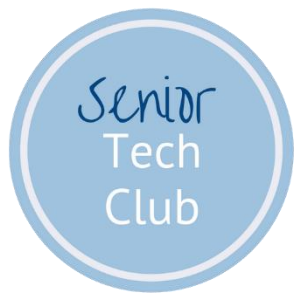
