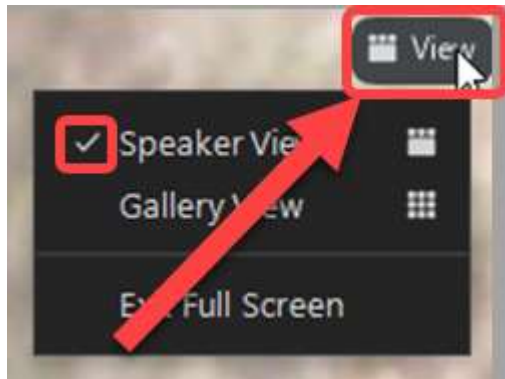

Photo Widget



Add a Photo Widget to the Home Screen – IOS 14

Jiggle Mode – Long Press on empty part of home screen.

Tap + (plus) add on upper left.

Browse or Search to find a widget.

Tap the desired Widget

Choose desired size and element (dots below display)

- Swipe left or right.

Tap **Add Widget** to place on Home Screen

Tap **Done** to leave Jiggle mode

Resolution

Your ability to get high quality photo enlargements depends on photo resolution.

Digital photos are comprised of millions of pixel (dots) that show as the image.

of pixels on an image is fixed

When enlarged, the pixel size must increase. Bigger pixels lose clarity.



Resolution – Good Enough for 8 x 10 inch Prints

iPhone Model Back Camera	Camera	
iPhone 4s, 5 & 6	8 megapixels	3264 x 2448 pixels
iPhone 6s to iPhone 12	12 megapixels	4032 x 3024 pixels

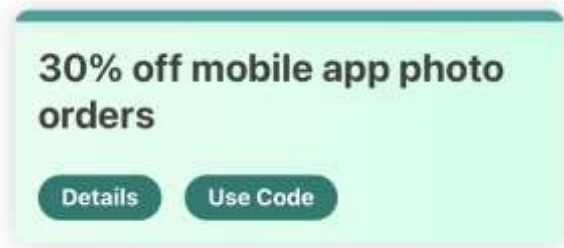
iPhone Model Front Camera (selfies)	Camera	
iPhone 11 & 12	12 megapixels	4032 x 3024 pixels
iPhone 8 – X	7 megapixels	3088 x 2320
iPhone 6s	5 megapixels	2576 x 1932
iPhone < 6	1.2 megapixels	1280 x 960

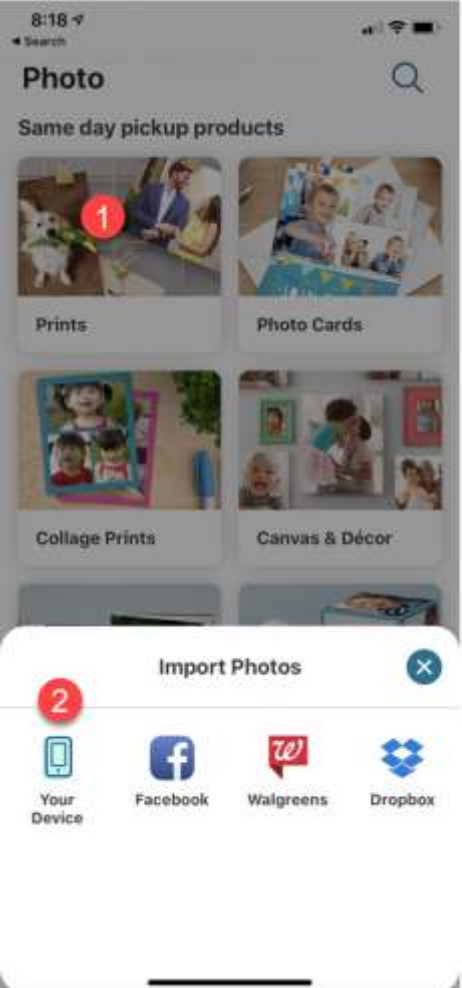
